







Cleaning and Maintenance

Clean exterior surfaces of the dispenser using warm water and mild soap. DO NOT USE ABRASIVE CLEANSERS. Dry with a soft cloth.

Cautions

- 1. It is the installer's responsibility to ensure that installation of the unit complies with all applicable codes standards and regulatory requirements.
- 2. Do not install this dispenser above heat sources or near sources of ignition/flame.
- Do not install where a failure of the mounting system or dripping of product from hands may cause damage to equipment or create a potential safety hazard.

L.E.D. Light Meaning

Flashing Red = Bottle not installed

L.E.D. Light Meaning

- 1. Full Green Bars = Full Bottle
- 2. Two Green Bars = Half Bottle
- 3. One Green Bar = Low Bottle
- 4. One Red Bar = Critically Low Bottle



L.E.D. Light Meaning

- 1. Full Green Bars = Full Battery
- 2. Two Green Bars = Half Battery
- 3. One Green Bar = Low Battery
- 4. One Red Bar = Critically Low Battery

Troubleshooting

(1) Dispenser not dispensing - indicator lights lit green

- a. Pump is seized in the dispenser. Remove the bottle, re-insert it properly. The disc of the pump must engage with the actuator, and the pump must be seated properly in the housing.
- b. Ensure that hand detecting sensors are not covered or contaminated.

(2) Dispenser not dispensing - no indicator lights lit

- a. Open and close the cover. Ensure that the cover is fully closed.
 Check if the dispenser is dispensing.
- b. Remove the battery cartridge, then re-install it. The lights should come on. If not, replace the battery cartridge or batteries.
